In case of fire



1. Alarm

- fire department: Call (0)118
- internal alarm / warn other persons



2. Close all doors and windows

- prevent fire from spreading



3. Rescue

- guide persons out of the risk area
- rescue and care for other persons



4. Extinguish

- extinguish with house intern extinguisher (if possible without risk)



5. Avoid elevators

In case of evacuation



1. Evacuation alarm

- the evacuation is signalled by sirens or announcements



2. Follow advices

- follow the advice of the evacuation helpers or announcements



3. Leave the building

- use emergency routes
- help persons in need



4. Assembly point

- go to the assembly point



5. Do not go back

- stay at the assembly point
- wait for further advice

In case of accident



1. Principle

- look – think – act
- care for your own safety



2. Alert

- ambulance: (0)144



3. Rescue

- bring injured person in the safe zone



4. First aid

- follow rescue-ABC(D)
Airway-Breathing-Circulation-(Defibrillation)



5. Care

- care for injured people
- support rescue forces

In case of chemical accident



1. Alert in case of trivial accident

- safety delegate
- alert internal / warn persons



2. Alert in case of major accident

- fire brigade: Tel. (0)118
- alert internal / warn persons



3. Close doors and windows

- prevent dangerous chemicals from spreading




4. Rescue
